SIGNAGE BYLAW

BYLAW # 6

Planning & Inspection Services

BE IT ENACTED by the Community Council of Mount Stewart that:


1. In this by-law "sign" includes any sign or signboard whatsoever
2. The Council may, by resolution, require the owner of real property upon which any sign is maintained or displayed to repair or remove the sign.
3. Notice of such a resolution shall be mailed by registered mail to the owner at his/her last known address and shall be posted on the property on which the sign is maintained or displayed.
4. The owner shall, within thirty (30 days) of the day on which the notice is mailed or the day on which the notice is posted (whichever is later) remove the sign.
5. All signs must meet Provincial Legislation.
6. No signs can project over a Public right of way.
7. No sign shall block a Public right of way.
8. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of a fine not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.

Effective Date

This by-law shall come into force effective the 1st day of April, 2001


