PARKING BYLAW

BY-LAW # 2

BE IT ENACTED by the Community Council of Mount Stewart that:


1. No vehicle shall be parked on any street within the Community between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. to allow for snow removal from November 1 – April 30th.
2. Vehicles not abiding by this bylaw will be towed at the Owner's expense.
3. All other traffic procedures shall fall in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act.
4. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw is guilty of a fine not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00.


Effective Date

This by-law received first reading at the Council meeting February 5, 2001





VILLAGE SERVICE ACT
VILLAGE OF MOUNT STEWART
BYLAWS

Under authority of Section 41 of the Village Service Act (R.S.P.E.I. 1974, Cap. V-5) Council did and doth hereby approve bylaws 1, 2, 3 and 4 respecting the parking of vehicles within the Village of Mount Stewart, which were made by the Village Commissioners of the Village of Mount Stewart on the 26th day of November, A.D., 1976. A copy of the said bylaws are attached to the file copy of this Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council and are also on file in the Office of the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

MOUNT STEWART VILLAGE BY-LAW

RE: MOTOR VEHICLES

1. No motor vehicle shall be stopped, left standing or parked on either side of any street within fifty feet from the centre of any intersection of two streets, within the Village. In the case of one street ending at such intersection, no motor vehicle shall be stopped, parked, or left standing within fifty feet of the point at which the continuation of such a street meets the street or intersection.
2. No person shall leave standing any motor vehicle within any space designated by the Commission as a "No Parking" area.
3. No motor vehicle shall at any time be stopped, parked or left standing on any portion of any street within the Village in such a manner as to inconvenience, impede or interfere in any way with the free passage of traffic on said street.
4. Speed limit in the Village shall be THIRTY miles per hour, unless otherwise designated by the Commissioners. Any person exceeding this speed limit in the operation of a motor vehicle shall be subject to the penalties provided for the violation of this by-law.
5. Any motor vehicle parked on any street or interrupting snow removal from December 1, 1976 to April 30, 1977, between the hours of twelve midnight and eight A.M. shall be towed away at owners expense, and any damage incurred during towing shall not be the responsibility of the Village of Mount Stewart.
